



USLC 2021 Voting Delegate Information and Election Procedure

Voting Delegate Policies and Procedures:

1. The Voting Delegates from each region will be appointed by the Regional Advisor(s) based on the region's membership as of February 1. Regional Advisors will send a list of their official Voting Delegates to the Florida HOSA State Office on or before Friday, March 12th. The Florida HOSA State Office will share the list with the members of the Credentials and Tellers Committee for verifying Voting Delegate ballots as they are received.
2. Prior to the virtual Business Session, a copy of the State Officer Candidate Ballot will be sent to the Regional Advisors to disseminate to the official Voting Delegates for their region.
3. The officially designated Voting Delegates will use the Zoom log-in code that will be sent to them by e-mail before the virtual Business Session to log-in. The virtual Business Session will take place Saturday morning, March 27th. The virtual Business Session will also be live-streamed to the official Florida HOSA YouTube Page (<https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCmmAj1Njhs8gBjVE7JRyH7w>).
4. Once the virtual Business Session has concluded, Voting Delegates will select one candidate for each State Officer position using the State Officer Candidate Ballot which they received from their Regional Advisor. The Voting Delegate will then save the ballot and send it as an attachment to the members of the Credentials and Tellers Committee for tallying. **The Credentials and Tellers Committee must receive the ballot before 1:00 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Time [EDT]) on Saturday, March 27, 2021 in order to be counted.**

If a Voting Delegate is not able to complete the ballot and send it as an attachment, he/she can send an e-mail to the members of the Credentials and Tellers Committee with the subject line reading, "*State Officer Election Ballot - (Voting Delegate's name and Region Name)*" and his/her selection for each position. For example:

Subject: *State Officer Election Ballot - Jane Doe, Emerald Coast Region*

President-Elect: Pat Doe
Northern Vice-President, Secondary: Jordan Jones
Southern Vice-President, Postsecondary: John Smith
Etc.

5. The newly elected State Officers will be announced during each of the 3 Awards Sessions (Middle School, Postsecondary, and Secondary) on Saturday, March 27th.
