



SLC 2022 Voting Delegate Information and Election Procedure

Voting Delegate Policies and Procedures:

1. The Voting Delegates from each Region will be appointed by the Regional Advisor(s) based on the Region's membership as of February 1.
2. All Voting Delegates **MUST** wear either the official HOSA uniform or a navy blue/black suit in order to vote (please see the Official Florida HOSA Dress Policy).
3. Voting Delegates will have the opportunity to "Meet & Greet" the slated State Officer candidates on Saturday, April 9th from 6:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. in the Crystal N-Q Rooms at the Marriott Orlando World Center.
4. Voting Delegates **MUST** report to the Voting Delegate Workshop (orientation) on-time to check-in and receive Business Session instructions. During the 2022 State Leadership Conference, the Voting Delegate Workshop will take place on Sunday, April 10th starting at 7:30 a.m. in the Crystal K-L Rooms.
5. Voting Delegates will receive a ribbon at the Voting Delegate Workshop that must be worn at all times. This ribbon will be needed to vote.
6. Immediately following the Voting Delegate Workshop, the Voting Delegates will go to the Business Session which will start at 8:15 a.m. in the Crystal Ballroom.
7. Once the Business Session has concluded, Voting Delegates will have time to caucus before voting begins. Voting Delegates may begin voting at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, April 10th outside of Conference Headquarters which is located in the San Francisco Room. Each Voting Delegate will sign-in on the official Voting Delegate List to receive a ballot. Voting will end at 12:30 p.m. that same day.
8. The newly elected State Officers will be announced that evening, Sunday, April 10th, during the Recognition Session.
