

SLC 2026 Voting Delegate Information and Election Procedure

- 1. The Voting Delegates from each Region will be appointed by the Regional Advisor(s) based on the Region's membership as of February 1st.
- 2. All Voting Delegates **MUST** wear either the official HOSA uniform or a navyblue/black suit during the Meet & Greet, the Voting Delegate Workshop, the Business Session, and to vote (please see the Official Florida HOSA Dress Policy on the Florida HOSA website for more information).
- 3. Voting Delegates will have the opportunity to "Meet & Greet" the slated State Officer candidates on <u>Thursday, April 16th from 5:45pm 6:15pm in Magnolia 8 & 9</u>. Voting Delegates must report to the Meet & Greet between <u>5:15pm and 5:30pm</u>.
- 4. Voting Delegates MUST report to the Voting Delegate Workshop (orientation) on time to check-in and receive Business Session instructions. If a Voting Delegate is not present at the Voting Delegate Workshop, they will not be allowed to be a Voting Delegate. During the 2026 State Leadership Conference, the Voting Delegate Workshop will take place on Friday, April 17th starting at 7:15am in Magnolia 10 & 11.
- 5. Voting Delegates will receive a ribbon at the Voting Delegate Workshop that must be worn at all times. This ribbon will be needed to vote.
- 6. Immediately following the Voting Delegate Workshop, the Voting Delegates will go to the Business Session which will start at **8:15am in the Cypress 2-3**.
- 7. Once the Business Session has concluded, Voting Delegates will have time to caucus before voting begins. Voting Delegates may begin voting at <u>10am on Friday, April 17th outside of Conference Headquarters which is located in Magnolia 1</u>. Each Voting Delegate will sign-in on the official Voting Delegate List to receive a ballot. Voting will end at 12:30pm that same day.
- 8. The newly elected State Officers will be announced that evening, Friday, April 17th, during the Recognition Session.
